Established over 27 years ago, and licensed by State & Federal Fish and Wildlife agencies, The Bird Rescue Center (BRC) is an established and important environmental resource for the North Bay area with a solid track record of success in wild bird rehabilitation and has one of the highest release rates for recoverable birds. It is the only all-bird rehabilitation facility in this area focused entirely on wild native birds, allowing it to devote all its time to their care and to further research into their needs.

The Bird Rescue Center is an important community resource for people in the region providing timely and valuable advice to the public on when, how and if to rescue a bird. The BRC Response Team fields over 10,000 calls each year. BRC helps to advance an awareness of and concern for our native wild birds through community education programs and presentations that reach all ages from school children to community organizations and senior groups.
