You can learn more about the 'Snowy Owls' we get calls about (aka Barn Owls in this area) with Garbo, our resident. Find out why Barn Owls (*Tyto alba*) are especially helpful for rodent control and why they're so adept at hunting in the dark.

Right now is the best time to clean out Barn Owl boxes because very soon they will start house searching. 'Bailing' babies have been a large percentage of the baby Barn Owls we get each year simply because there's no
