Release of a Red Shouldered Hawk



A Red Shouldered Hawk (#2252) was admitted on October 27th from West Santa Rosa after striking a window. The hawk suffered an impact spinal injury, and was having difficulty standing and unable to fully extend its left wing.

During the hawks time at the center, it became agitated and did extensive damage to its tail and right wing feathers.

By December 16, the hawk was fully recovered from its injury and having sixteen (16) feathers replaced through a process called "imping". The hawk was successfully released in West Santa Rosa.
